## Webinar Overview

On the eve of the Global Accessibility Awareness Day, G3ict, in collaboration with global experts and partners, has developed and is now delivering online workshops to encourage cities worldwide to adopt the [G20 Smart City Alliance Public Procurement Model Policy](#). This free webinar on May 19<sup>th</sup> will be targeted specifically to local governments in Europe but open to participants worldwide. The webinar will raise awareness of the model policy and provide both a compelling rationale and guidance for cities to adopt it.

The webinar is intended to promote broad interest and uptake of the G20 Smart City Alliance Public Procurement Model Policy. More specifically, there are five key learning objectives for all webinar participants from cities across Europe and worldwide:

1. Understanding the basics of accessible ICT procurement policy and standards for local governments.
2. Understanding how accessible technology deployments and smart solutions will benefit cities and their various communities.
3. Understanding the core components of the G20 Smart City Alliance Public Procurement Model Policy.
4. Understanding how to take immediate and specific next steps to adopt the model policy in their city.
5. Understanding how to apply for supplemental direct technical assistance from G3ict and global experts to adopt the model policy, i.e. the [Inclusive Procurement Launchpad program](#).
